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Why?	Financial institutions choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	The types of personal information we cowith us. This information can include: • Social Security number • Income • Account balances	 Credit history Credit card or other debt Checking account information 	
How?	All financial institutions need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons CJFCU chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.		

Reasons we can share your personal information	Does CJFCU share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes - such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No
For our marketing purposes - to offer our products and services to you	No	We don't share
For joint marketing with other financial companies	Yes	No
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your transactions and experiences	No	We don't share
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness	No	We don't share
For nonaffiliates to market to you	No	We don't share

What We Do			
How does CJFCU protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. CJFCU also maintains other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect your information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.		
How does CJFCU collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Apply for a loan Provide employment information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.		
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.		
Definitions			
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • CJFCU has no affiliates.		
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • CJFCU does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.		
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies
